Parish Finance Committee Update



The \$600,000 loan from the Lender to the parish expired on 31st October 2020.

Archbishop Costelloe has conditionally approved a loan of \$600,000 from the Archdiocese to the Attadale parish in order for the parish to repay the Lender made to the parish for the completion of building of the new church.

Acknowledging that negotiations are taking place around leasing parish land to a developer the following conditions apply to the loan from the Archdioceses:

- The loan is to be repaid in full if and when the developer project is completed and lease payments commence;
- If the developer initiative does not come to fruition the parish is to actively pursue other means of raising the required funds (eg other long term tenants, sale of land);
- Until the parish is in a position to repay the loan an annual payment of \$3,000 must be made to the Archdiocese; and
- An annual review is to take place in October 2021 and 2022.

If no leasing options have been entered into by October 2021 then sale of land will need to be explored.

November Masses Throughout the month of November we recommend to God the souls in purgatory that He may soon bring them to His Glory, especially those of our relatives, friends and enemies and those we are bound to pray for. Votive Candles

The Sight of burning votive candles - - is common in most Catholic churches. The candles are usually placed before statues of saints or at shrines. But how did this tradition get its start?

According to A Handbook of Catholic Sacramentals, by Ann Ball, the practice of lighting candles in order to obtain some favour probably has its origins in the custom of burning lights at the tombs of the martyrs in the catacombs.



The lights burned as a sign of solidarity with Christians still on earth. Because the lights continually burned as a silent vigil, they became known as vigil lights. Vigil Lights (from the Latin vigilia, which means "waiting" or "watching") are traditionally accompanied by prayers of attention or waiting.

Another common type of candle offering is the votive light. Such an offering is indicative of seeking some favour from the Lord or the saint before which the votive is placed. Lighting a candle is a way of extending one's prayer and showing solidarity with the person on whose behalf the prayer is offered. I would encourage you to light a candle, which has been the custom of the parish over the years. Thankfully we now have two new votive stands generously donated by a parishioner and from the proceeds of the High Tea Sunday.

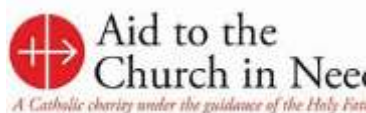
