TENEBRAE

Wednesday 27th March 2024, 7:00pm

The Tenebrae service, Latin for "shadows" or "darkness", is a moving ancient tradition towards the end of Holy Week to reflect on the events of Palm Sunday through to the night of Jesus' burial on Good Friday.

As scripture readings tell the story of Holy Week, the flames of a many branched candelabra are extinguished allowing us to experience the growing gloom and darkness of the events.

With the death of Christ, the Church is plunged into darkness, a loud noise is heard representing the sealing of Christ's tomb, before a lighted candle is presented to symbolise Christ's resurrection.
