A very personal relationship

When people go to Rome on pilgrimage, they usually include a visit to the Catacombs, the earliest Christian cemeteries. One of the images of Jesus is that of the Good Shepherd. One is in the Catacomb of San Callistus, showing a young beardless man with a sheep draped around his shoulders and holding a bucket of water in his right hand. The shepherd image conveys the personal nature of the relationship between Jesus and his followers. When Jesus says 'I lay down my life for my sheep', he is saying that he lays down his life for each one of us individually. Today is Vocations Sunday. The Lord has a calling that is personal to each one of us.

Parents know how distinct and unique each of their children is. They are all given the same love; they grow up in the same environment. Yet, from a very early age, their uniqueness becomes very evident. The family is a microcosm of the church as a whole. From the time of our baptism, we are each called to follow the good Shepherd. However, the way we do that will be unique to each one of us. Each person in this church can do something for the Lord that only he or she can do. At times we feel like the rejected stone. We are never rejected in the Lord's eyes. He sees us as the keystone for some aspect of his work. On this Vocations Sunday, we commit ourselves anew to hearing and responding to the call of the Good Shepherd.

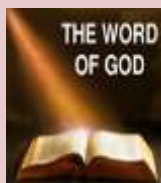
Anzac Day Prayer

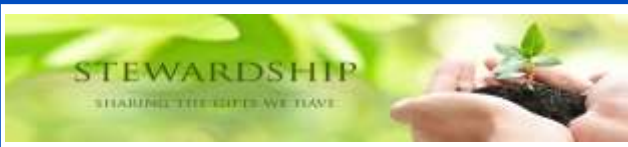
